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Key Responsibilities:

- In-Process & Final Inspections
 - Receipt inspections, dimensional/visual checks, release verification and traceability
 - Collaborate with production teams to resolve quality issues and drive continuous improvement
 - Ensure quality compliance with shipping regulations, company procedures & customer requirements
- Physical Testing
 - Testing Methods
 - Complete and maintain all quality instruments
 - Data analysis
 - Sample retention
- Equipment Calibration & Maintenance
 - Maintain all quality equipment/instruments calibration schedules, preventative maintenance and out-of-tolerance reporting
 - Manage site-level procurement of quality materials, supplies, and services in alignment with company policies and budget
- Reporting & Continuous Improvement
 - Maintain accurate records in ERP and quality systems
 - Support new product/process introductions and change management activities
 - Quality Management System documentation and performance
